This Policy is established in line with the Occupational Safety and Health Act 1994, the Occupational Safety and Health (Amendment) Act 2022, and the guidelines issued by the Department of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) Malaysia.

OUR COMMITMENT

- Provide and maintain a safe place of work, safe systems of work, and safe equipment for everyone at WCP.
- Identify, assess, and control hazards before work begins, through proper risk assessment (HIRARC).
- Comply fully with OSHA 1994, the 2022 Amendment, and all related Malaysian safety regulations.
- Provide information, instruction, training, and supervision needed to work safely.
- Investigate every accident, near-miss, and unsafe condition, and take corrective action.
- Continually review and improve our safety performance through regular review and feedback.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF ALL PARTIES

Management: Provides resources, leads by example, and ensures this Policy is implemented and reviewed.

Employees & Contractors: Follow safety rules and procedures, use protective equipment correctly, and work without putting themselves or others at risk.

Everyone: Reports any unsafe condition, hazard, or incident immediately to the Assets & Facilities Division.

Safety and health shall be accorded the highest priority at all times. This Policy applies to all staff, contractors, tenants, and visitors at Wisma Chase Perdana, and shall be reviewed periodically to ensure it remains effective and relevant.
